Promotion of Research

It will also provide opportunity for researchers to gain experience in writing research proposals and reports, publications, and intellectual property rights, among other things.

Identification of Thrust Areas

Despite the fact that academics are free to choose their own study topics, the Shri GPM Degree college research committee will examine all research proposals for their social relevance. The Research Cell collaborates with various subject instructors to develop a list of research subjects on which they might concentrate their efforts. In addition, the Research Cell works closely with a variety of stakeholders, including students, academics, and industry professionals, to identify pressing challenges that require immediate attention.

As a result, the research cell keeps its list of research ideas, areas, and topics up to date and distributes them with students and professors.

Training for Research and Publications

Shri G.P.M. degree college encourages sharing of expertise within and among the neighbouring colleges of higher learning to publish research papers and channelize their efforts, in addition to stimulating research temperament.
