- It is conducted by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports of the Government of India.
- The scheme was launched in Gandhiji's Centenary year on 24 September 1969.
- NSS has more than 3.2 million student volunteers on its roll spread over 298 Universities and 42 (+2) Senior Secondary Councils and Directorate of Vocational Education all over the country.
- From its inception, more than 3.75 crores students from Universities, Colleges and Institutions of higher learning have benefitted from the NSS activities, as student volunteers.

Symbol

- The symbol for the NSS has been based on the giant Rath Wheel of the world famous Konark Sun Temple (The Black Pagoda) situated in Orissa, India.
- The wheel portrays the cycle of creation, preservation and release and signifies the movement in life across time and space.
- The symbol thus stand for continuity as well as change and implies the continuous striving of NSS for social change.



Badge

- The NSS symbol is embossed on the badge.
- The eight bars in the wheel represent the 24 hours of a day.
- The red colour indicates that the volunteer is full of young blood that is lively, active, energetic and full of high spirit.
- The navy blue colour indicates the cosmos of which the NSS is tiny part, ready to contribute its share for the welfare of the mankind.

Eligibility & Programs

- The NSS unit in the college enrolls students as per the NSS guidelines and directions of the University of Mumbai.
- Eligibility for enrolment 10+2 from any stream
- Capacity 1 units with total strength of 60 volunteers
- NSS is a 2 years continuous program
- Completion of 120 hours work per year are mandatory
- NSS volunteer certificate will be issued after completion of 240 hours in 2 years and at least one 7 days residential camp must be attended in two years
- This scheme gives an opportunity to students to develop organizational skills, leadership qualities and a sense of social consciousness.
- Various projects are undertaken by the NSS volunteers on and off the campus.
