Instructions to the Candidates

- 1) You should be present at the place of your examination *at least 30 minutes before the commencement* of the examination along with your *ID-Card and Hall Ticket*. Possession of both of which is **ABSOLUTELY COMPULSORY.**

- d) The test data and the output.
- e) Viva-Voce (will be mostly confined to the topic related to the practical that you are attempting)

FOR PROJECT

a) Documentation: 30 marks

b) Quality of the project: 15 marksc) Working of the project: 20 marksd) Project Presentation: 15 marks

e) Viva: 20 marks
